## **PUBLIC NOTICE No. 01 /2021**

**Sub:** Conduct of online examination under Regulation 6 of Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018 by the National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics (NACIN), Faridabad-Reg.

Attention of the Customs Brokers and all the members of the trade are invited to the above mentioned subject. The written examination of Customs Brokers Licensing Examination, 2021, shall be conducted by NACIN, Faridabad on **24.03.2021** at the designated centres across India.

The applications for the examination, complete in all respects, shall be submitted in person or by Registered/Speed post in Form A (available in the CBLR, 2018) along with two passport size photos, self attested documents on citizenship (Aadhar/Passport/Voter Card), proof of educational qualifications, financial viability, mobile number, e-mail id and other requirements as Annexure attached along with the prescribed fee of **Rs. 500/-** (Rupees five hundred only) to the Commissioner of Customs, Custom House, Willingdon Island, Cochin - 682 009 from **11.01.2021 to 10.02.2021 up to 6:00 p.m.** Applications sent by post, in case received after the last date (10.02.2021) shall not be entertained.

Before submitting the application, applicant should ensure the completeness of the application. Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected.

The online written examination will be a Computer Based Examination with Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of two and half hours (10:30 hrs to 13:00hrs) duration. Questions will be bilingual i.e. in English and Hindi. The pattern of the examination will be as follows:

The syllabus of examination is prescribed in Regulation 6 (7) of the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018, as amended. Those qualifying in the said examination will have to appear for oral examination in terms of Regulation 6 of the said Regulations.

The oral examination will be held during the second quarter of the calendar year 2021. The pass percentage marks for qualifying in the oral examination will be 60%.

A dummy question paper for the purpose of awareness of the candidates will be made available on CBIC and NACIN websites [www.cbic.gov.in](http://www.cbic.gov.in) and [www.nacin.gov.in](http://www.nacin.gov.in) under the icon/tab <GSTP/CBLR EXAM> from **February, 2021**. A link to download the admit card will also be provided therein. Admit card shall also be sent by e-mail to eligible applicants 12 days in advance before the date of examination. For convenience of the candidates, other necessary details like list of centres, guidelines to the candidates, help desk, e-mail id etc will also be made available under the said icon/tab.

  - (a) he is a citizen of India;
  - (b) he is a person of sound mind;
  - (c) he is not adjudicated as insolvent;

  - (f) he has not been penalised for any offence under the Act, the Central Excise Act, 1944 (1 of 1944), the Finance Act, 1994(32 of 1994), the Central Goods and Services Act, 2017 (12 of 2017) and Integrated Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (13 of 2017)
  - (g) he has neither been convicted by a competent court for an offence nor any criminal proceeding is pending against him in any court of law.
